### Suggested starter activity

- 1 Guide a discussion about things they know about animals which are true.
- 2 Explain that the word 'fact' means that something is true, and that 'fiction' means that something is made up or not true.

### Extension activity

- 1 Use the supplied flashcards with the words 'fact' and 'fiction' on them. Hand a set out to each pupil.
- 2 Read a few sentences to the class and ask pupils to raise the correct card to show if what you are reading is a fact (true) or fiction (made up). You could use the following sentences or find some of your own.
  - Dogs have four legs. (fact)
  - Sharks live in the sea. (fact)
  - Fish can talk. (fiction)
  - Agoutis can play football. (fiction)
