Suggested starter activity

Sentence joining game

This game can be played after completing exercises 2–4 on pages 109–110 in the Student's Book.

- 1 Place pupils into groups of four.
- 2 Give each group three sentences on strips of paper.
- 3 Ask the groups to find, in the sentences they have been given, those that can be joined together using the word 'but' to show the difference between the two halves of the sentences.
- 4 Once each group has sorted and found the sentences that join together, ask them to stick them down on a piece of paper and write the word 'but' in the middle to link the two.
- 5 Ask the class to read each joined-up sentence out loud together.
